More bad news, the Judge's recommendation was to deny the protests and the Administrator agreed with that recommendation. I don't have all the details, our attorneys have the paperwork and are looking it over. The Judge's recommendation was approximately 100 pages long and it will take some time to go through it. A redacted version will be released, but that will probably take a couple of weeks to accomplish.

The next question is where do we go from here? There is an appeal process, but at this point I would say that would not be something we would follow. I'll wait until our attorneys have time to digest the entire decision and the BOD will make that decision.

The Senate may still introduce some language tomorrow in full committee, we'll have to see if a Senator will stand up and introduce the language. Wally is back and I'll attach his update to this message.

I'm sorry gang, I honestly believe that the attorneys did everything in their power to show what a farce this whole mess was, but it wasn't meant to be. Please make sure your paperwork is complete for job offers, retirements, or any other avenue you choose to take. More importantly take care of yourselves and your families that's what life is really about.

We'll have an update on the EEOC case in the next day or two and I'll be watching the Senate tomorrow to see what happens.
