We are requesting that the FLRA revoke the existing certification of exclusive representative held by the National Association of Air Traffic Specialists. Due to a recent reduction in force action that eliminated over 2000 bargaining unit positions, only about 116 employees remain AFSS employees employed by the Federal Aviation Administration. We believe this is no longer an appropriate national unit. There continue to be employees in Alaska and at the Command Center in Virginia. We propose that there be a revocation of the existing certification of exclusive representative for the National NAATS unit that, prior to October 4, 2005, represented 2200 employees.
